Rail Construction to Resume Closures of Three Lanes of Both Directions of I-495 at Route 123 Sunday Night, Aug. 21

Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction crews are scheduled to resume closures of the following lanes at the I-495/Route 123 interchange in Tysons Corner from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, Aug. 21:

Northbound I-495

- **Three left lanes** of northbound I-495, from 2,000 feet south of Leesburg Pike (Route 7) to Route 123

Southbound I-495

- **Three left lanes** of southbound I-495, from Old Dominion Drive to Route 123

Brief, 30-minute maximum total closures of the Beltway **may** be required for equipment moves. Overnight lane closures in both directions of I-495 can be expected through the end of the year. Information on specific lane closings will be announced daily.

Motorists are urged to use extreme caution, and pay attention to signage when traveling through this area. Police will be on site. All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will not have any lane closures at this interchange Friday or Saturday nights.
