Ramps from Eastbound Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH), Dulles Toll Road to Route 7 to Detour Tonight for Crane Move

Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews plan to move a large crane between work sites at the Leesburg Pike (Route 7) interchange with the eastbound Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) and Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) tonight, Wednesday, August 24. Closures and detours are as follows:

Eastbound DIAAH exit ramp to Leesburg Pike (Route 7) – closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: Stay on the eastbound DIAAH and take the next exit toward I-495 and Route 123. Exit at Route 123 south, follow Route 123 south just past International Drive, and then take the Route 7 exit (on the right).

Eastbound Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) exit ramp to eastbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7) – also closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Detour: Stay on the eastbound Toll Road and take the exit to westbound Route 7. Once on westbound Route 7, U-turn at the first intersection, Jarrett Valley Drive, to re-route on to eastbound Route 7. *(As a courtesy, please do not turn around in the Jarrett Valley Drive neighborhood.)*

Intersection of Leesburg Pike (Route 7) and Tyco Road – closed from midnight to 5 a.m.

Eastbound Route 7 traffic will not be able to turn left on to northbound Tyco Road. Westbound Route 7 traffic will not be able to turn left on to southbound Westwood Center Drive. Thru traffic to/from Tyco Road and Westwood Center Drive also will not be allowed.

Detour: Turn on to Route 7 and U-turn at the next allowable intersection to access the opposite direction of Route 7 and turn lanes to Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive.

Thru traffic will remain open on eastbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7).



Motorists are urged to use extreme caution, and pay attention to flaggers and signage when traveling through this area. Police will be on site. All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.
