Dulles Rail Construction to Cause Service Changes This Weekend between East and West Falls Church Stations on Metro's Orange Line

Metrorail service between the East Falls Church and West Falls Church along the Orange Line will be replaced by shuttle bus service this weekend because of Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction.

Starting at 10 p.m. on Friday night, July 22, and continuing through closing on Sunday night, July 24, customers should allow an additional 20 to 30 minutes to trips along this corridor.

Both the East and West Falls Church station will remain open. The shuttle services are free.

According to Metro, the last train will depart Vienna 20 minutes earlier than usual—at 2:08 a.m. Friday and Saturday nights and at 11:08 p.m. on Sunday.

Rail construction crews will be preparing the connections for the new rail line to the existing line.

In addition this weekend, Metro crews will be replacing cross ties and insulators along the Orange Line between Vienna and West Falls Church stations, causing trains to operate every 24 minutes and share one track.
