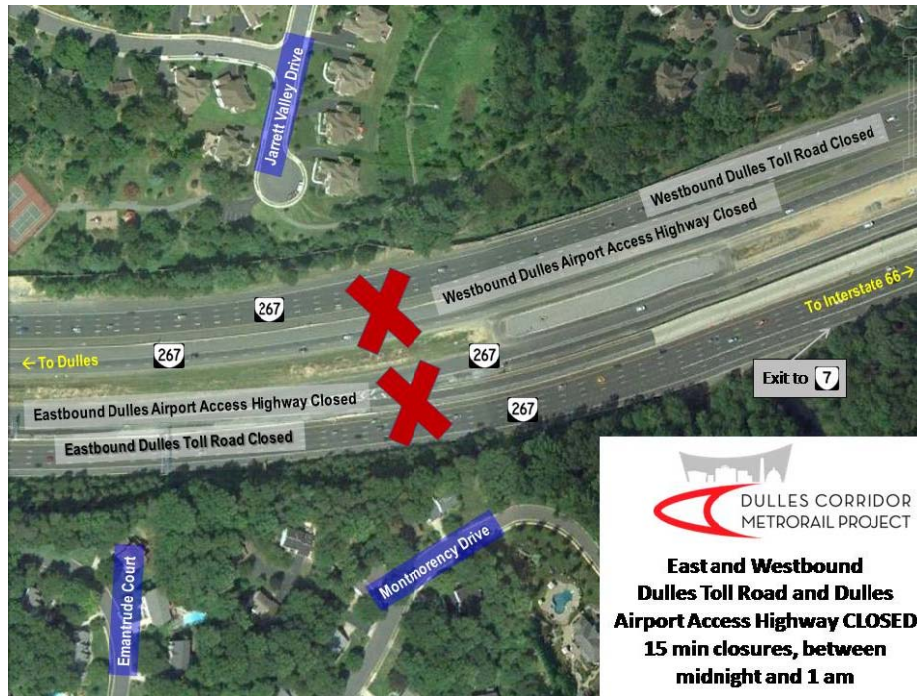
URGENT: Emergency Full Closures of Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) and Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) Planned West of Route 7 Overnight Monday Between Midnight and 1 a.m. for Power Line Repair

The Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) and Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) will be closed in both directions between Route 7 and Trap Road for no more than 15 minutes at a time in the overnight hours of Monday, Oct. 10 into early Tuesday morning, Oct. 11. Crews will be replacing an overhead power line.

These closures will occur between midnight and 1 a.m. Monday night/Tuesday morning, between mile markers 10.0 and 11.0 just west of Route 7. **There will be no detour** – police will stop all traffic in both directions while crews replace the overhead line.

If traveling to or from Washington Dulles International Airport during this one-hour window, please plan your travel accordingly. Motorists using the DIAAH and Toll Road can expect significant delays during these times. All work is weather pending and subject to change.
