UPDATE: Paving to Continue This Week over Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road at Route 7

Paving at the Route 7/Westpark Drive-Gosnell Road intersection is nearing completion, and is expected to continue in the overnight hours through much of this week for Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction. The work may be delayed in case of inclement weather.

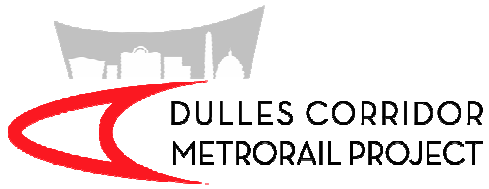
Thru traffic along both directions of Leesburg Pike (Route 7) still will be allowed, but the following lanes will be closed:

- Left and center thru lanes of **westbound** Route 7 closed from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m.
- Right and center thru lanes of **westbound** Route 7 closed from 2 a.m. to 5 a.m.
- Left turn lane of **westbound** Route 7 on to Gosnell Road, closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Left turn lanes of **eastbound** Route 7 on to Westpark Drive, closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Thru traffic on Westpark/Gosnell **will not** be allowed, and will be detoured by using Route 7 as follows:

- Southbound Westpark Drive thru traffic to Gosnell Road **and** motorists wanting to turn left on to eastbound Leesburg Pike will need to turn right on to westbound Leesburg Pike, then U-turn at either Spring Hill Road or Tyco Road, and continue on eastbound Leesburg Pike towards Gosnell Road.
- Northbound Gosnell Road thru traffic to Westpark Drive **and** motorists wanting to turn left on to westbound Leesburg Pike will need to turn right on to eastbound Leesburg Pike, pass under Route 123, turn left on International Drive, left on Chain Bridge Road (Route 123), then take the exit ramp to Route 7 to turn right on Westpark Drive.

Noise warning: Every effort will be made to minimize the noise associated with this work. **However, paving is an extremely dangerous activity and will require the full use of backup alarms to ensure workers' safety.**
