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Route 7 Utility Relocation for Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project

**UPDATED TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Daytime Closures and Construction Activities for
the Route 7 Utility Relocation for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project**

The Virginia Department of Transportation announces the following lane closures along Route 7; Leesburg Pike as part of the Route 7 Utility Relocation for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project, weather permitting.

Route 7 East

What: Right and left shoulder closures
When: Monday through Thursday, August 25-28, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
Where: The shoulder on the south side of eastbound Route 7 between the ramp from eastbound Route 7 to the eastbound Dulles Connector Road and the ramp from the eastbound Dulles Access Road to westbound Route 7; and the shoulder on the north side of eastbound Route 7 on either side of the ramp from the eastbound Dulles Access Road to westbound Route 7. **(See attached map)**
Why: Test Bore

NOTE: Signs and construction barrels will be placed in the area to alert motorists to traffic pattern changes. Both shoulders will not be closed at the same time.

The work will be done weather permitting.
