Tysons Corner Utility Relocation for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project

Weather permitting; the following lane closures are scheduled:

Dulles Airport Access Road East (Route 267) to Leesburg Pike West (Route 7) Night work

When: Fri., Wed. and Thurs. nights, Nov. 7, 12 and 13, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (See attached detour route **MAP 1**)
Where: Dulles Airport Access Road east (Route 267), ramp to Leesburg Pike west (Route 7)
Why: Utility relocation

Dulles Toll Road and Access Road East (Route 267) to Leesburg Pike East (Route 7) Night work

When: Fri., Wed. and Thurs. nights, Nov. 7, 12 and 13, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (See attached detour route **MAP 2**)
Where: Dulles Toll Road and Access Road east (Route 267), ramp to Leesburg Pike east (Route 7)
Why: Utility relocation

Leesburg Pike East (Route 7) to Dulles Toll Road East (Route 267) Night work

When: Fri., Wed. and Thurs. nights, Nov. 7, 12 and 13, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (See attached detour route **MAP 3**)
Where: Leesburg Pike east (Route 7), ramp to Dulles Toll Road east (Route 267)
Why: Utility relocation

In addition, closures will continue in several sections of the service roads on both sides of Leesburg Pike (Route 7); Leesburg Pike between Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) and the Dulles Access Road. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to alter their travel on these service roads. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the work periods.
