Tysons Corner Utility Relocation for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project

Weather permitting; the following lane closures are scheduled:

Night Work Lane Closure

Leesburg Pike West (Route 7) Night work

When: Sun. and Mon. nights, Nov. 2 and 3, 9:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Left turn lane partial closure (left turns will still be possible)
Where: Leesburg Pike west (Route 7) at Gosnell Road
Why: Utility relocation

Night Work with Ramp Closures and Detours

All of the following night closures and corresponding detours will be done each night, November 4th through 6th. **Please note these closures will not occur simultaneously.**

Leesburg Pike East (Route 7) to Dulles Toll Road East (Route 267) Night work

When: Tues. through Thur. nights, Nov. 4-6, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (**See attached map 1 for detour route**)
Where: Leesburg Pike east (Route 7), ramp to Dulles Toll Road east (Route 267)
Why: Utility relocation

Dulles Airport Access Road East (Route 267) to Leesburg Pike West (Route 7) Night work

When: Tues. through Thurs. nights, Nov. 4-6, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (**See attached map 2 for detour route**)
Where: Dulles Airport Access Road east (Route 267), ramp to Leesburg Pike west (Route 7)
Why: Utility relocation

Detour night work continued...

Dulles Toll Road and Access Road East (Route 267) to Leesburg Pike East (Route 7)
Night work

When: Tues. through Thurs. nights, Nov. 4-6, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Ramp closure (**See attached map 3 for detour route**)
Where: Dulles Toll Road and Access Road east (Route 267), ramp to Leesburg Pike east (Route 7)
Why: Utility relocation

In addition, closures will continue in several sections of the service roads on both sides of Leesburg Pike (Route 7); Leesburg Pike between Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) and the Dulles Access Road. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to alter their travel on these service roads. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the work periods.
