I-66 and Route 267 Work Starts Tonight

This is a reminder that Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction activities will begin tonight Thursday, June 25, 2009, in the grassy areas between Route 267 and I-66. Notices of this work were emailed last week to local officials. Residents of nearby communities received notices by mail.

The night work begins at 8 p.m. in what the project refers to as Laydown Area 1. It is located at the I-66/DCR interchange.

Proactive measures have been taken to mitigate the impact of this work on the neighbors.

Weather permitting, work should continue night work tomorrow (Friday) night. No work scheduled for Saturday night but night work resumes on Monday, June 29 through Wednesday, July 1. There will be no construction activity Thursday, July 2, throughout the holiday weekend.
