Updated Lane Closures

Weather permitting, the following additional lane and shoulder closures have been **rescheduled** for the week of Nov. 16, 2009, due to adverse weather:

Traffic shift: Beginning on or around **Wednesday, Nov. 18**, motorists should expect a traffic shift of the northbound lanes of Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) between Anderson Road and the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) overpass. This shift will move lanes approximately eight feet to the east (right) around a work area, and is expected to last four to six weeks.

Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) South Day Work

What: Right turn lane closed
Where: Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) southbound **from 300 feet north of Scotts Crossing Road to Capital One Drive**
Why: Equipment staging for utility work

When: Mon., Nov. 16, 9:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Left thru lane closed
Where: Leesburg Pike (Route 7) **westbound from Spring Hill Road to Tyco Road**
Why: Utility work
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

Leesburg Pike (Route 7) East Day and Night Work

What: Left thru lane closed



Where: Leesburg Pike (Route 7) eastbound, **from the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) to 100 feet east of Westwood Center Drive**

Why: Utility work

Police: Onsite for motorist safety

In addition, closures will continue in several sections of the service roads adjacent to east and westbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7); Leesburg Pike between Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) and the Dulles Toll Road. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the work periods.

There also will be occasional lane closures along the Dulles International Airport Access Highway and the Dulles Toll Road.

Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to alter their travel along these roads.
