Lane closings along I-66 this week

Dulles Metrorail work begins tonight in highway median

OCT. 13, 2009. Work along a stretch of I-66 near the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) will begin tonight as part of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project's future tie-in with Metro's existing Orange Line.

This will require construction crews to travel I-66 between the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) and Route 29 (Lee Highway) this week.

Crews will close the left lane of westbound I-66 from just east of the Great Falls Street overpass to the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) flyover. They will clear trees in the median between the roadway and the Orange Line tracks. This clearing work will occur Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday night.

Barrier placements will force the closure of two *right* lanes of westbound I-66 on Thursday night *only*.

All work is scheduled from midnight to 5:00 a.m. to not disrupt daytime traffic along I-66, or Metro's Orange Line regular runs. **Drivers should stay alert and use extreme caution when traveling areas along this part of I-66 during these hours.**
