New Traffic Pattern at Scotts Crossing Road and Chain Bridge Road (Route 123)

Residents and commuters living and working around Scotts Crossing Road should prepare for a long-term traffic shift beginning on or before Monday, Sept. 21, weather permitting.

Scotts Crossing Road will be reduced to one northbound through lane, and one left-turn and one through lane southbound (*see map below*). This traffic shift will last through the end of the project, which is scheduled to complete in 2013.

This traffic shift supports the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project's construction of the future Tysons East Metro station and accompanying at-grade and aerial track work for Phase 1 of the new Metrorail extension.

Occasional lane closures may be required as work progresses in this area. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared for these construction activities.
