## **URGENT: Detours of I-66 at Dulles Connector Road Cancelled through Sept. 6**

I-66 westbound at the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) will **NOT** be closed overnight tonight or any other night this week, according to the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.

The closings are scheduled to resume occasional overnights starting on Tuesday, Sept. 7, after Labor Day, weather permitting.

Details of next week's closings will be announced later this week.

The closures have been taking place to allow Dulles Rail construction crews to build large concrete structures that straddle over the road between piers, which will support bridges and structures carrying the new rail line near where it will merge into Metro's existing Orange Line.
