Long-Term Right Lane Closure on Southbound Route 123 to Begin Early Next Week for Metrorail Station Construction

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is beginning construction of the Tysons East station, to be located along the northwest side of Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123), between Scotts Crossing Road and Capital One Drive.

To begin construction, **the right lane of southbound Route 123 between Scotts Crossing Road and the I-495 Capital Beltway Inner Loop must close for approximately two years** to allow workspace for crews to operate away from traffic and ensure that the Metro station can be built safely.

Weather permitting, this closure is expected to begin as early as Monday night, Feb. 8. (Should this work be delayed by the impending snowstorm and snow removal, we will notify the public of an updated closure date.)

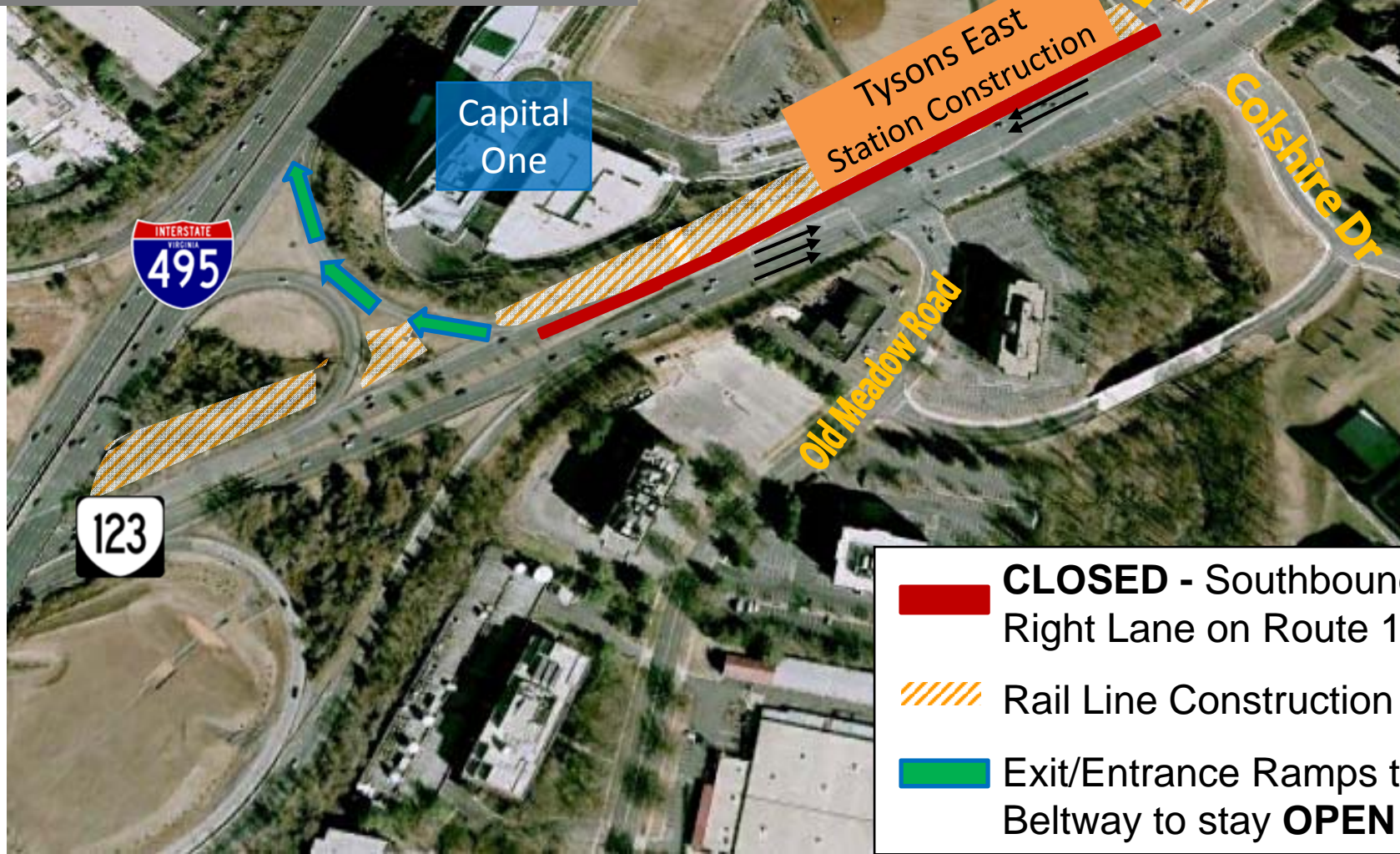
Capital One employees, vendors and visitors will still have right-turn lane access to the property's main entrance via a shorter right-turn lane. Both entrance ramps to the Capital Beltway will also remain open.
