Ramp from Route 123 South to Eastbound I-66/Dulles Connector Road Closing March 8 for Three Months

Construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is causing the closing of the on-ramp from southbound Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) to the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) toward I-66 for approximately three months beginning Monday, March 8.

Crews will be building piers and caissons to support piers near the Dulles Connector Road bridge across Route 123. This is between McLean and Tysons Corner.

Traffic using southbound Route 123 from the McLean area to reach eastbound I-66 and the Connector Road will be encouraged to use the following detour to access the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (*See attached map*):

- Continue south on Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123)
- Turn left on Colshire Drive
- Turn right on Colshire Meadow Drive
- Turn right on Old Meadow Road
- Turn right on to northbound Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) to enter the on-ramp to eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267 toward eastbound I-66).

The detour has been approved by the Virginia Department of Transportation.

This closing is necessary to permit crews to build these piers safely, away from traffic and to protect motorists.

Weather permitting, this work will begin Monday night, March 8.
