Ramp from Route 123 South to Eastbound I-66/Dulles Connector Road to Remain Closed through October

The on-ramp from southbound Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) to the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) toward I-66 will remain closed through October because of on-going construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.

The ramp first closed in March and was scheduled to reopen last month. However, construction continues in this area on several piers and caissons to support the bridges to carry the aerial tracks from the median of the Dulles Connector Road to the northwest side of Route 123 toward the future Tysons East Metrorail Station.

The Virginia Department of Transportation has approved the rail project team's request to keep the ramp closed until pier construction is finished.

Drivers using southbound Route 123 from the McLean area to reach eastbound I-66 and the Connector Road have been the most affected by the detour, and continue to be encouraged to use the following detour to access the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (*See attached map*):

- Continue south on Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123)
- Turn left on Colshire Drive
- Turn right on Colshire Meadow Drive
- Turn right on Old Meadow Road
- Turn right on to northbound Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123) to enter the on-ramp to eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267 toward eastbound I-66).

This closing is necessary to permit crews to build these piers safely, away from traffic and to protect motorists.
