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## **Additional Lane Closures July 20-23, 2010**

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project today announced lane closings this week along the Dulles International Airport Access Highway, the Dulles Toll Road, Route 7 (Leesburg Pike), Spring Hill Road and Westwood Center Drive in Tysons Corner.

Left and right lanes of the eastbound **Dulles Airport Highway** are closed in some segments, including portions just east of the Beulah Road overpass, during non-rush hour periods day and night through Friday, July 23.

Through Friday night motorists on the **Dulles Toll Road** motorists can expect:

- Westbound near Wiehle Avenue: narrowing of the ramp and lane closing
- Eastbound near Wiehle Avenue: lane closing
- Ramps to Route 7 will be narrowed for paving operations. Drivers should be alert for barriers.

### **On Leesburg Pike west:**

- Tomorrow, Wednesday, July 21 through Friday, July 23 from 9:30 p.m. to 2 a.m., the far right turn lane at Tyco Road will be closed.

### **On Leesburg Pike east:**

- Friday night, July, 23 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., the two left through lanes from the Dulles Toll Road to east of Spring Hill Road will be closed for paving

Paving operations will cause multiple lane closings on Spring Hill Road and Westwood Center Drive during this time period.

All work will be done weather permitting.

Here are details of additional lane and shoulder closures:

### **Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) East Day and Night Work**

When: Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 23, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.  
What: Right thru lane closed  
Where: **Between mile markers 5.5 and 6.0**  
Why: Paving and barrier relocation  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety for night work only

When: Tuesday, July 20 – Friday, July 23, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.  
What: Left thru lane closed  
Where: **Between mile markers 8.0 and 8.5**  
Why: Moving barrier for construction entrance  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

When: Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 23, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.  
What: Left thru lane closed  
Where: **Between mile markers 9.4 (500 feet east of the Beulah Road overpass) and 9.9**  
Why: Setting barrier  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety for night work only

### **Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) West Day Work**

When: Wednesday, July 21 – Friday, July 23, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.  
What: Ramp narrowing and right lane closed  
Where: **Between mile markers 6.2 (Wiehle Avenue ramp) and 5.5**  
Why: Paving and barrier restoration  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety for night work only

### **Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) East Day Work**

When: Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 23, 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.  
What: Left thru lane closed  
Where: **Between mile markers 5.5 and 6.0**  
Why: Paving and barrier restoration  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety for night work only

**Ramp Work: Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) to Leesburg Pike (Route 7) Night Work**

When: Monday, July 19 – Thursday, July 22, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.  
What: Ramp narrowing **(No detour required)**  
Where: **Exit ramp from the eastbound Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) to both directions of Leesburg Pike (Route 7)**  
Why: Barrier placement and paving  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

**Leesburg Pike (Route 7) West Night Work**

When: Wednesday, July 21 – Thursday, July 22, 9:30 p.m. to 2 a.m.  
Friday, July 23, 9:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.  
What: Far right turn lane closed  
Where: **At Tyco Road**  
Why: Support lane closures of Westwood Center Drive (see below)  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

**Leesburg Pike (Route 7) East Night Work**

When: Friday, July 23, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.  
What: Two left thru lanes closed  
Where: **From the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) to 400 feet east of Spring Hill Road**  
Why: Paving  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety  
Note: Rescheduled from an earlier date due to rain

**Spring Hill Road North Day and Night Work**

When: Thursday, July 22, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.  
Friday, July 23, 9:30 a.m. to noon  
What: Right turn lane and right thru lane closed  
Where: **At Leesburg Pike (Route 7)**  
Why: Curb restoration

What: Right thru lane closed

Where: **For a 400-foot stretch north of Leesburg Pike (Route 7)**  
Why: Paving  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety  
Note: Rescheduled from an earlier date due to rain

#### **Westwood Center Drive North Night Work**

When: Wednesday, July 21 – Thursday, July 22, 9:30 p.m. to 2 a.m.  
Friday, July 23, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.  
What: Left thru lane and left turn lane closed  
Where: **At Leesburg Pike (Route 7)**  
Why: Drainage installation, paving and striping  
Police: Onsite for motorist safety



When: Wednesday, July 21 – Thursday, July 22, 2 a.m. to 5 a.m.  
Friday, July 23, 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

What: Right thru lane and right turn lane closed

Where: **At Leesburg Pike (Route 7)**

Why: Drainage installation, paving and striping

Police: Onsite for motorist safety

Note: Work will follow the completion of the previous listing

### **Westwood Center Drive South Night Work**
