## **Crews to Hang Steel Girders at Pimmit Run Bridge *Short Traffic Delays Expected on Dulles Connector Road***

On or about Tuesday night, August 3, Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews will begin erecting steel on the new bridge that will carry the new rail line over Pimmit Run, weather permitting.

This work will require short closures of the eastbound and/or westbound lanes of the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267). The closures are expected to last approximately 10 minutes and will be set up as needed while girders are placed.

This work is expected to take two nights, and will be performed between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

An example of what drivers can expect is pictured here. This photo was taken when steel girders were erected over Magarity Road earlier this summer.

Drivers are urged to exercise extreme caution on the Connector Road. Police will be on site to set up closing and direct traffic.
