Lane Shifts of Dulles International Airport Access Highway near Wiehle Avenue Station begin June 11-12

Significant shifts in the eastbound and westbound lanes of the Dulles International Airport Access Highway will begin on or about June 11-12 near Wiehle Avenue and east of Reston Parkway.

The shifts are needed to expand the construction site and work zone where the Wiehle Avenue Metrorail Station is now being built in the median of the Airport Road and the Dulles Toll Road lanes.

Piers that will support the platform of the station, located west of Wiehle Avenue, are already in place. Actual station construction requires much more space than now exists, forcing the lane shifts to create a wider work area.

The first of two planned lane shifts is scheduled overnight on Friday, June 11 and in the early morning hours of Saturday, June 12. The eastbound lanes will move to the right beginning about three quarters of a mile west of the Wiehle Avenue overpass and ending on the east side of the overpass. Two lanes of through traffic will be maintained on the shifted lanes.

The westbound shift in the same area will take place near July 1. Specific dates will be announced later.

These traffic patterns will be in place for about three years, until the Wiehle Avenue Station is completed. All work is done weather permitting.

Drivers are encouraged to use extreme caution on the airport lanes during this shift and throughout construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is a 23-mile extension of the existing Metro system, providing service from East Falls Church through Tysons Corner, Reston, Herndon, Washington Dulles International Airport to Ashburn. The project is being built in two phases. Phase 1 is now under construction. The project is owned and managed by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority.
