Pedestrian Safety Alert: Traffic Signal Changes on Route 7 at Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road in Tysons Corner

Pedestrians in Tysons Corner should pay special attention when using the new crosswalks being installed this week at Route 7 at the intersection of Westpark Drive and Gosnell Road during recent major lane shifts and widening of Leesburg Pike (Route 7) (*see map*).

Because of the widening in this area, pedestrians now have time only to cross half of Route 7 during a "green" traffic signal cycle. To remedy that, a new traffic signal is being installed that will require pedestrians to stop in the median, press a newly installed signal button, and wait for a signal to cross to the other side of the street. **Pedestrians should not attempt to cross the entire width of Route 7 in one green light cycle.**

This is necessary to help ensure the safety of pedestrians crossing the wider road.

Pedestrians must exercise extreme caution when crossing Route 7, and motorists should pay close attention to the new traffic patterns in this area.
