Overnight Work Increasing this Summer

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is ramping up operations this summer, especially in the median of the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) and near the four station sites in Tysons Corner on Routes 7 and 123, starting Sunday night, June 27.

Concrete pours will begin during night shifts so that crews can take advantage of cooler pre-dawn temperatures. Pours will begin around 2 a.m. The overnight hours will also keep pace with the project's construction schedule which requires a high volume of concrete work.

Every effort will be made to minimize the impact of noise in work areas between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m.

This work does not generally generate noise and any impacts caused by additional truck traffic will not impact traffic flows.
