Nighttime Detour for the Eastbound Dulles Airport Access Highway

Nighttime drivers using the eastbound Dulles International Airport Access Highway will experience a slight detour from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning on or about Tuesday, May 25 when crews begin constructing large concrete supports for two piers for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project just east of Route 123. The detour will be in place Wednesday, May 26 and continue intermittently over the next five to six weeks.

Traffic will be detoured on to the eastbound Dulles Toll Road near the Spring Hill Road/International Drive exit after the main toll plaza— well in advance of the work area. Detoured drivers will not pay tolls.

Drivers should pay close attention to signage. All work will be done weather permitting.
