## **REMINDER: Lane Shift on Westbound Route 7 Takes Place Overnight Tonight**

A lane shift along the westbound lanes of Route 7 between Route 123 and Westpark Drive in Tysons Corner will take place overnight tonight, Friday, Oct. 15, between 9:30 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Tonight's lane shift will take place westward from SAIC to the west side of Westpark Drive.

Additional shifts of westbound Route 7 are scheduled as follows:

- From the west side of Westpark Drive to the east side – on or about Saturday, Oct. 23
- From the east side of Westpark Drive to Spring Hill Road -- approximately mid-November.

All work is weather permitting.

The lane shifts are part of the widening of Route 7 to create space in the median for construction of two of the five stations in Phase 1 of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is a 23-mile extension of Metro's existing Orange Line. The project is managed and owned by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. The design-build construction contractor is Dulles Transit Partners.
