Important Lane Closures Sept. 20-24, 2010

Lane Shifts on Eastbound Route 7 begin Sept. 24, 25

Another round of significant lane shifts will take place next weekend along Route 7 in Tysons Corner.

These shifts will take place along the westbound lanes of Route 7 overnight on Sept. 24 and 25, when the roadway will move to the right (north of the existing roadway) into space where service roads used to parallel the highway.

On Friday night, Sept. 24, the lanes from Spring Hill Road west to Tyco Road will be shifted. The work will be completed Saturday a.m.

On Saturday night, Sept. 25, the lanes between Westpark Drive east to the SAIC complex will be shifted. The work will be completed Sunday a.m.

These are the first of several shifts of westbound Route 7 between Route 123 and the Dulles Toll Road over the coming weeks. All of these shifts will be completed by mid-October.

Since early summer, the eastbound lanes of Route 7 from the Toll Road to Route 123 have been shifted between 40 and 60 feet in some areas. The lane shifts create large medians between the eastbound and westbound lanes in which the Tysons Central 7 and the Tysons West Metrorail stations are being built.

REMINDER: Ramp Closure and Reconfiguration of Frontage Road to Be Implemented Friday Night, Sept. 17

The ramp from southbound Route 123 to westbound Route 7 is scheduled to close for four months starting tonight, Friday, Sept. 17.

When that happens, traffic accessing westbound Route 7 will be diverted to the Frontage Road, which runs parallel to Route 123 and eventually down the hill to Route 7. This is expected to last through the end of the year.

The traffic will be diverted just south of the Marriott Courtyard, slightly past International Drive. Business access will remain open at all times.

If the traffic shift is delayed, crews will perform the work in the overnight hours of Saturday, Sept. 18.

Nighttime Closures of Westbound I-66 to Resume Next Week

Overnight closures of westbound I-66 at the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) split will resume Thursday, Sept. 23 through Saturday, Sept. 25, causing significant detours.



Traffic will not be allowed to flow below this construction work for safety reasons. It is also important to note that the overhead clearance when the road is open is 15 feet.

The closings will happen during overnight hours from midnight to 5 a.m. All lanes will be reopened by morning rush hours. This round of I-66 closures is expected to finish in the early morning hours of Sunday, Sept. 26.

When I-66 westbound lanes close, thru traffic will be detoured on to the Dulles Connector Road westbound, to Route 123 south toward Tysons Corner, to a right turn to the on-ramp to the Capital Beltway south toward Richmond. Drivers can then rejoin I-66 from the Beltway. For local traffic, drivers have options to exit I-66 prior to the closing.
