## **Important Lane Closures Oct. 4-8, 2010**

### **Multiple Lane Closings at Tysons Boulevard and Route 123 Coming During Next Two Weeks**

Multiple daytime lane closures of Tysons Boulevard at Chain Bridge Road in Tysons Corner will begin on or about Monday, Oct. 4.

Dulles Rail crews have been building piers for aerial bridge construction in this area for several months. Motorists in this area should use extreme care and watch for signage.

#### **Eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) at Route 123 to Close Nightly Oct. 3-8**

Crews will close the eastbound Dulles Connector Road at Route 123 nightly Oct. 3-8 between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Motorists will be required to detour as follows:

- Exit the Connector Road on to the southbound I-495 Capital Beltway (toward Richmond/Alexandria)
- Exit immediately on to northbound Route 123 (toward McLean)
- They can then rejoin the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267 toward I-66/ Washington)

#### **Nighttime Closures of Westbound I-66 at Connector Road Scheduled Oct. 1, 2**

Overnight closures of westbound I-66 at the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) split are scheduled to take place tomorrow Friday, Oct. 1, and Saturday, Oct. 2.

Weather permitting, the closings will happen during overnight hours from midnight to 5 a.m. All lanes will be reopened by 5 a.m. Please note that the overhead clearance when the road is open is 15 feet.



When I-66 westbound lanes close, thru traffic will be detoured on to the Dulles Connector Road westbound, to Route 123 south toward Tysons Corner, to a right turn to the ramp to the Capital Beltway south toward Richmond. Drivers can then rejoin I-66 from the Beltway. For local traffic, drivers have options to exit I-66 prior to the closing.

### **Route 7 Lane Shift Update; Expect Heavy Overnight Construction**

Multiple lanes closures, shifts, and paving are taking place along the westbound lanes of the Route 7 in Tysons Corner in preparation for a series of lane shifts that are expected to take place this month. Work is also being done on Spring Hill and Tyco Roads.

Most of this work is being done at night. Drivers are encouraged to use extreme caution driving on Route 7 between the Dulles Toll Road and Route 123.

Ongoing utility relocations will require that these lane shifts be done in phases. Dates will be announced as soon as they are available.

### **New Ramp from Southbound Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) to Westbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7) to Close Overnights Beginning Sunday, Oct. 3**

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project recently changed the way drivers get from southbound Route 123 to westbound Route 7 by routing traffic on to Frontage Road, which runs parallel to Route 123 north of Route 7.

To improve the new exit to Frontage Road, additional work is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 3 through Thursday, Oct. 7 during the overnight hours.

Frontage Road will be completely closed between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. on those dates. **However, the work will be phased to permit business along Frontage Road, such as Clyde's Restaurant, to remain open until normal closing times.**

Detours are recommended as follows:

#### **From southbound Route 123 to westbound Route 7:**

**Continue on southbound Route 123 and turn right on Gosnell Road to access both directions of Route 7**

#### **From westbound Route 7 to southbound Route 123:**

**Continue on westbound Route 7, turn right on Westpark Drive, right on Greensboro Drive, right on International Drive, then right on to southbound Route 123**



Police will be onsite for motorist safety.
