Overnight Closures of Frontage Road Oct. 3-7

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project recently changed the way drivers get from southbound Route 123 to westbound Route 7 by routing traffic on to Frontage Road, which runs parallel to Route 123 north of Route 7.

To improve the new exit to Frontage Road, additional work is scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 3 through Thursday, Oct. 7 during the overnight hours.

Frontage Road will be completely closed between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. on those dates. **However, the work will be phased to permit business along Frontage Road, such as Clyde's Restaurant, to remain open until normal closing times.**

Detours are recommended as follows:

From southbound Route 123 to westbound Route 7:

Continue on southbound Route 123 and turn right on Gosnell Road to access both directions of Route 7

From westbound Route 7 to southbound Route 123:

Continue on westbound Route 7, turn right on Westpark Drive, right on Greensboro Drive, right on International Drive, then right on to southbound Route 123

Police will be onsite for motorist safety.
