## **Lane Shifts of Eastbound Route 7 from Dulles Toll Road east to Tyco Road Set for overnight Friday, Feb. 25**

Drivers using eastbound Route 7 in Tysons Corner can expect another lane shift related to Dulles Corner Metrorail Project construction overnight tomorrow, Friday, Feb. 25.

Eastbound lanes will be shifted southward by about 25 feet between the Dulles Toll Road east to Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive, near the Tysons Sheraton Hotel.

The work will take place between 9:30 p.m. Friday night and 7 a.m. Saturday morning.

This lane shift will help create a wider median in the middle of Route 7 where the Tysons West Metrorail Station and aerial tracks will be built.

Meanwhile this week crews are finishing the necessary paving for this shift causing some traffic slowdowns in the section of Route 7, and will soon complete striping of the new lanes.

There will continue to be a dedicated left turn on to Tyco Road, two through lanes, and one right-turn/through lane. The new traffic pattern is expected to be in place for approximately one year.

In case of inclement weather, this lane shift will be rescheduled for overnight Saturday, Feb. 26.
