REMINDER OF NIGHT WORK

As a reminder of earlier communication, the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is working to relocate a water line along Route 123 from Anderson Road to the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267). This work has been going on for some time, but in order to decrease the impact on traffic on Route 123 during the day, and remain on schedule, the contractors will need to do some night work for approximately one week, beginning on August 12, weather permitting.

The Project has met with the contractors to ensure they take any and all practical steps to reduce nighttime noise; however local residents may notice some increased noise.

If you are disturbed by back up alarms or other noise at night, please contact the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Hotline immediately at 877-585-6789. They will quickly get a message to the nighttime Field Engineer, who will assess the situation and see if additional steps can be taken to mitigate noise.

Also, as a traffic reminder, the exit ramp from eastbound Route 267 (Dulles Connector Road) to northbound Route 123 (Dolley Madison Blvd.) will be **closed** during the nighttime hours this work is being performed.

Drivers will be directed to detour by using the ramp to southbound Route 123 and using the traffic signal to access the northbound lanes. Police will be on site for motorist's safety.
