TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Lane Closures on Service Roads along Route 7 in Tysons Corner

NEW CLOSURES:

What: Closure of both lanes of the south service road.
When: On or about Wednesday, July 9 until Monday, July 14
Where: Sections of the service road on the south side of Route 7, east of Spring Hill Road, in front of **Embassy Suites Hotel, Best Buy, Office Depot and Thomasville Furniture.**
Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.
NOTE: All entries to businesses will remain open.

What: Nighttime closure of both lanes of the frontage road for approximately 200 feet.
When: Between Midnight and 5:00am each night from Wednesday, July 9 until Friday, July 11
Where: **Frontage road on the north side of Route 7, near Route 123**
Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.
NOTE: Access to all businesses will remain open

CONTINUING CLOSURES:

What: Closure of both lanes of the south service road.
When: Continuation of closure until approximately Monday, July 21.
Where: Sections of the service road on the south side of Route 7, east of Spring Hill Road, in front of **Rosenthal Nissan Mazda and Infiniti of Tysons Corner.**
Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.
NOTE: Access to all businesses will remain open.

What: Daytime closure of one lane of the frontage road for approximately 200 feet.
When: Continuation of closure through Friday, July 18.
Where: **Frontage road north side of Route 7, near Route 123**

Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project
NOTE: Traffic will be allowed towards northbound Route 123 in the daytime; access to all businesses will remain open

What: Closure of both lanes of the south service road.
When: Continuation of closure through Friday, July 18.
Where: Service road on the south side of Route 7, from **Marshalls Drive to Route 123**.

Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.
NOTE: Access to **Wendy's and Koons Chevrolet** from the service road will remain open.

Access to all businesses throughout the area will remain open, but motorists should stay alert for changing routes. Construction barrels will be placed in the area to alert motorists to traffic pattern changes on the service road and into businesses. The work will be done weather permitting.
