WEEKEND RAMP CLOSURES SCHEDULED DULLES TOLL ROAD EAST TO I-495 *Detours will be in place*

ALEXANDRIA— On Saturday, Jan. 22 and Sunday, Jan. 23 from 7 a.m. until noon each day, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will close an exit ramp from the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) east leading to I-495 north and south to allow crews space for bridge pile-driving work. For safety reasons, the following ramps will be closed with a detour in place:

- **Saturday, Jan. 22:** Dulles Toll Road east to I-495 south
- **Sunday, Jan. 23:** Dulles Toll Road east to I-495 north

Detour Route: On Saturday, Jan. 22, motorists heading to I-495 south will be directed to continue east on the Dulles Toll Road to Exit 19, Route 123 south, turn right at the traffic signal onto Route 123 south and follow signage to I-495 south. On Sunday, Jan. 23, motorists heading to I-495 north will be directed to I-495 south, to Exit 46B, Route 123 north, follow the signage to turn left onto I-495 north.

Dulles Toll Road motorists may encounter delays approaching the I-495 interchange especially during peak day and evening hours. Should inclement weather delay the work the ramp closures will be rescheduled. This work is part of the Capital Beltway High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes Project.

**Winter weather can have frequent impacts on planned lane closures. Expect closures to be rescheduled to account for inclement weather. Media will be notified and this web site will be updated:*
