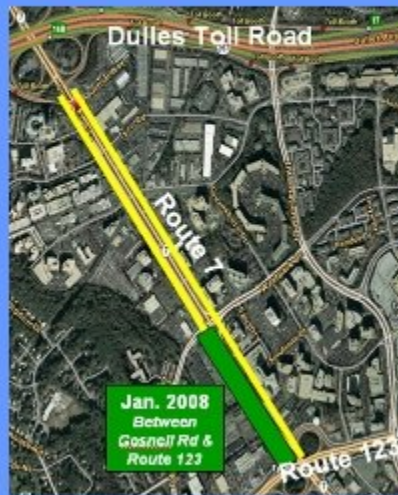

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project has started utility relocations along Route 7 between Route 123 and the Dulles Toll Road. These relocations are necessary prior to starting the construction of the rail project.

## Work has Started along Service Roads



Utility work has started with Washington Gas Company working in the service road south of Leesburg Pike in front of Business Bank (east of Gosnell Road) and moving east towards Route 123.

Short sections of one lane of the service road will be closed as work requires and traffic will be eastbound only in that section. The work lane will reopen after construction is completed. Access to all businesses will be maintained.

## Enhancing Route 7

*Improving Travel Flow & Pedestrian Access on Leesburg Pike*



The utility relocations are part of the Route 7 enhancement along the future rail project alignment.

Additional Project Improvements:

- Utilities to be moved underground
- Sidewalks added on both sides
- Route 7 widened to four lanes in each direction
- Dual left turns at Tyco, Spring Hill and Gosnell/West Park intersections
- Pedestrian bridges across Route 7 and 123
