### Traffic Advisory

#### **Night work on Route 7 in Tysons Corner Lane closings coming west of Route 123**

The Virginia Department of Transportation announced lane closures on Route 7 in Tysons Corner during the overnight hours of Sunday, June 15. Motorists using east and west bound lanes of Route 7 immediately west of Route 123 will experience lane closings between the hours of 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

During this work, one or two travel lanes will be sequentially closed between Route 123 and Marshall's Drive/Frontage Road. Traffic barriers and barrels will be used to mark traffic patterns. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m., Monday, June 16.

The work is part of utility relocation on Route 7 in preparation for the future construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project. The closings will take place, weather permitting, to allow installation of data collection points to monitor the installation of utility lines across Route 7. All work is being done in the VDOT right of way.
