### **Detour Set at Route 7/Dulles Toll Road Interchange for Utility Relocation for Dulles Metrorail**

**TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Day and Night Closures and Construction Activities for  
the Route 7 Utility Relocation for the Dulles Metrorail Project**

The Virginia Department of Transportation announces the following revised ramp closures along Route 267; Dulles Toll Road and Dulles Access Road as part of the Route 7 Utility Relocation for Dulles Metrorail Project, weather permitting.

#### **Route 267; Dulles Toll Road East to Route 7; Leesburg Pike West (Night work)**

When: Wednesday through Friday nights, August 20–22, 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.  
What: Ramp closures (See attached detour route **MAP 1**)  
Where: Route 267; Dulles Toll Road east, ramp to Route 7; Leesburg Pike west  
Why: Utility relocation

#### **Route 267; Dulles Toll Road and Access Road East to Route 7; Leesburg Pike (Night work)**

When: Monday through Wednesday nights, August 25–27, 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.  
What: Ramp closures (See attached detour route **MAP 2**)  
Where: Dulles Airport Access Road east, ramp to Route 7; Leesburg Pike east  
Why: Utility relocation

**NOTE: Motorists are advised to use extreme caution in this area during this period.** Detours will direct motorists to local streets including Spring Hill Road, Tyco Road and the Toll Road. Motorist will be directed with electronic signs, fixed signs and assorted traffic control devices. Traffic will return to normal patterns during daylight hours.
