TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Night Work: Route 7 East, Before Ramp to Route 123 South, Two Right Lanes Closed Approaching Route 123 and Re-open at Corner. Right Turns to Route 123 South Open

The Virginia Department of Transportation announced that the right two lanes on Route 7 East, the far right turn-lane to Route 123 South and the right through-lane will be closed for approximately forty-feet before the Route 123 overpass. Both lanes re-open to traffic by the corner allowing right turns onto Route 123 south and Route 7 through traffic. Nights and times listed below:

- What:** Night work, Route 7 East, two right lane closures on approach to Route 123.
- Where:** Route 7 East, approximately 40-feet before Route 123. Both right lanes re-open to traffic before the Route 123 overpass. Right turns onto Route 123 South open.
- When:** Nights: 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.: Monday, May 5 to Saturday, May 10; and again on Monday night, May 12 to Saturday May 17
- Why:** Night work closures necessary for Washington Gas utility relocation work in preparation for the future construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.
