TRAFFIC ADVISORY: Lane Closures on Service Roads along Route 7 in Tysons Corner

NEW CLOSURES:

What: Closure of one lane of the drive on the side of the Ernst and Young building, entering the north service road along Route 7.

When: On or about Thursday, August 7 through Monday, August 11

Where: A section of the drive leading to the service road on the north side of Route 7, west of Westpark Drive, east of the Tysons Jeep dealership and along the side of the **Ernst and Young** building.

Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.

NOTE: Electronic signs and barrels will direct traffic. All entries to businesses will remain open.

What: Closure of a short section (both lanes) of the north service road.

When: On or about Tuesday August 5, until Friday, August 8

Where: A section of the service road on the north side of Route 7, west of Spring Hill Road, in front of the **Ourisman and Koon's Toyota** dealerships.

Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.

NOTE: All entries to businesses will remain open.

CONTINUING CLOSURES:

What: Closure of both lanes of the south service road.

When: Continuation of closure until approximately Monday, August, 18.

Where: Sections of the service road on the south side of Route 7, east of Spring Hill Road, in front of **Rosenthal Nissan Mazda** and **Ruth's Chris Steak House**.

Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.

NOTE: Access to all businesses will remain open.

What: Nighttime traffic pattern change of the frontage road for approximately 200 feet.
When: Continuation of work evenings from 9:30pm to 5:00am each night through Thursday, August 7.
Where: **Frontage road north side of Route 7, near Route 123 near Orvis and the Kitchen and Bath Store**
Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project
NOTE: A flagger will direct traffic on the frontage road during nighttime work
Traffic will continue to be open towards northbound Route 123 in the daytime; access to all businesses will remain open

What: Closure of both lanes of the south service road.
When: Continuation of closure through Monday, August 18.
Where: Service road on the south side of Route 7, in front of **Koons Chevrolet near Route 123.**
Why: Utility relocation in preparation for the Dulles Rail Project.
NOTE: Access to **Koons Chevrolet** from the service road will remain open.

Access to all businesses throughout the area will remain open, but motorists should stay alert for changing routes. Construction barrels will be placed in the area to alert motorists to traffic pattern changes on the service road and into businesses. The work will be done weather permitting.
