## **Urgent Safety Reminder: More Lane Shifts of Eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) at Bus Ramp Loop and Flyover I-66**

Motorists and bus drivers who use the eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) toward I-66 east and the bus loop into West Falls Church Station should be aware of another lane shift that will remove the temporary exit currently in place since July, and move the bus exit closer to the station for ongoing Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction.

The two eastbound lanes and bus lane will once again remain together until the new bus lane exit. (The current configuration splits the thru traffic and buses, and forces each to exit on to their respective lanes.)

This split is expected to be implemented today, Nov. 29 through Wednesday, Nov. 30, and will be in place through early 2012. If nighttime work is necessary, every attempt to minimize nighttime noise will be made, though nearby neighborhoods may hear increased activity during paving, which is an extremely dangerous operation.

This lane shift will allow crews to continue constructing the tunnel that will carry future Metro trains from the median of the Connector Road, under the roadway, and into the expanded West Falls Church Yard.
