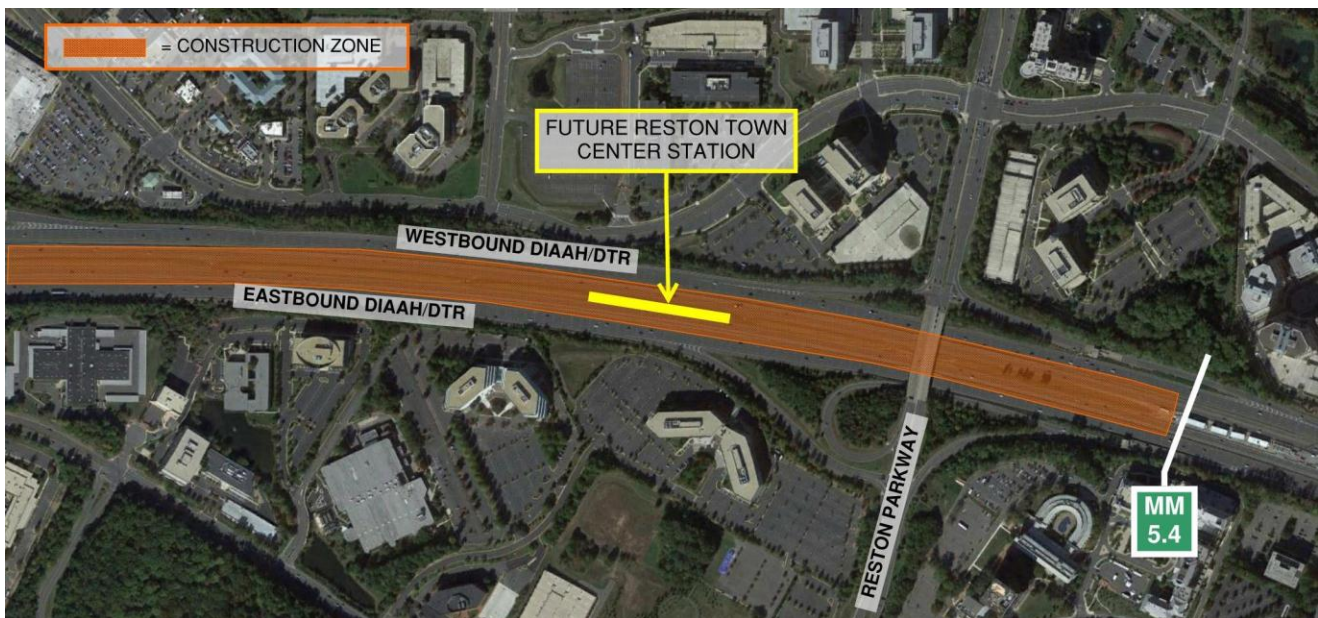
Road Work Expands Along Dulles International Airport Access Highway

On or about the week of March 23, Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews will install traffic barriers along the eastbound and westbound lanes of the Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) near Reston Parkway and the Silver Line's future Reston Town Center Station.

Lane and shoulder closures will occur from just east of the Reston Parkway overpass, westward through the existing construction zone for the future Herndon Station (between mile marker 5.4 and 3.2) during daytime and nighttime hours. Work will continue through the spring and summers.

Shoulders and lanes will be closed and reopened in phases when crews install barriers, perform road work and lane shifts, and install utilities for the station. Large, slow-moving vehicles may be exiting and entering the highway at various times. Drivers are asked to exercise caution and to watch for to all signage, barricades and other changing conditions in the construction zones.

All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
